# **User Tips: Optimizely**

## Navigation/User interface

- Use the All Properties view when creating/editing. The view toggle options are in the right corner of the window.
- You can pin the Navigation and Asset panes to keep them open as you work.
- Press the button at the page level to see your progress.

## **Creation/editing**

## **Properties**

Below are the standard properties options for Page. These contain important editable fields.

- Header: For
  Lontent Header Page Settings SEO Settings header text and image.
- Page Settings: For page image and summary (visible in page cards on landing pages) and page colour
- **SEO**: For meta-title, keywords, -description and -image.

### **Compare versions**

Press the compare different versions button to view past versions of the page (next to Preview).

Users can see via All Properties or On-page via the Select Compare mode toggle.

### **Blocks**

- For new blocks, creating and publishing are **different actions**. Be mindful of this.
- Multi-layered blocks (e.g. accordions, document/link lists, videos) require users to publish conten at each level. User guides for all the blocks are available in the <u>Website Design</u> environment.
- There are additional settings for blocks under **Block Settings**, including margins and colour options.



#### **Brand**

• The brand (colour) scheme will be managed by the web-team/Manager in alignment with brand guidelines. 'Children' pages will be the same as the colour of 'parent' pages (higher in the IA). The web-team will ensure an even-spread of the brand colours across the website.

# Media ('Assets')

- Use hyphens to fill the blank spaces in the file name (best practice).

- The file type extension will automatically be added when the item is added to the CMS.
- The Asset file structure can be expanded (chat to web-team)

- Graphics = PNG format
- Image = JPEG format preferred

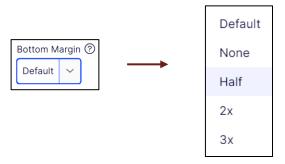

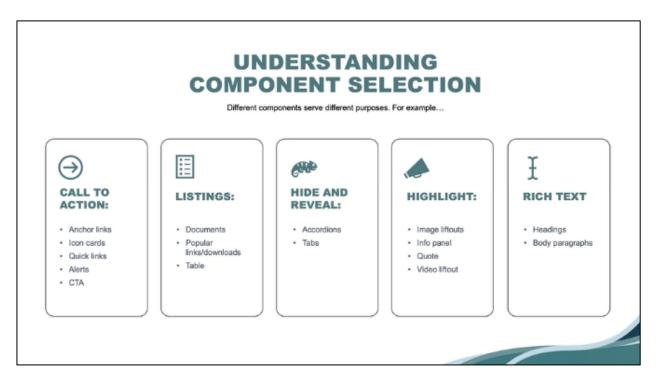

### **Artificial reefs**

Artificial reefs are man-made reefs installed off the Western Australia (WA) coast to improve recreational fishing opportunities. The reefs can be made of steel or reinforced concrete and can be tower or cube shaped.

DPIRD has collaborated with <u>Recfishwest</u> to install a number of purpose-built artificial reefs around WA. Fishers can find current artifical reef details such as coordinates and reef depth on the Recfishwest website.
